I have audited the balance sheet of The Libertarian Party of Canada as at December 31, 2007 and the statements of revenue and expenses, net assets, and financial transactions return for the year then ended. The financial transactions return and related financial statements are the responsibility of the Party. My responsibility is to express an opinion on the financial transactions return and related financial statements based on my audit.

I conducted my audit in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards and Section 424 of the Canada Elections Act. Those standards require that I plan and perform an audit to obtain reasonable assurance whether the financial transactions return is free of material misstatement. An audit includes examining, on a test basis, evidence supporting the amounts and disclosures in the financial statements. An audit also includes assessing the accounting principles used and significant estimates made by management, as well as evaluating the overall financial statement presentation.

As is the case with other political parties, The Libertarian Party of Canada derives most of its revenue in the form of donations, the completeness of which is not susceptible to satisfactory audit verification. Accordingly, my verification of these revenues was limited to the amounts recorded in the records of the Party and I was not able to determine whether any adjustments might be necessary to donation revenues, excess of expenses over revenues, assets and net assets.

In my opinion, subject to the above limitation, the financial transactions return presents fairly, in all material respects, the financial position of the Party as at December 31, 2007 in accordance with Canadian generally accepted accounting principles and Section 424 of the Canada Elections Act.
