## Direct Deposit Enrolment or Change Request



This form is for the use of a registered political party, a candidate's official agent, a person designated by the official agent of the candidate to receive payment, or an auditor to arrange direct bank deposit of payments to which they are entitled under the *Canada Elections Act*.

**To set up direct deposit**, simply fill out the form and return it to the following address, together with a voided cheque or a document approved by your financial institution. You can also use the form to change your instructions for direct deposit.
