

Working away from home?

Plan ahead with these voting options!

Vote when you ARE home



At the Elections Canada office in your riding

When:
Until the Tuesday before election day, 6 p.m.
Visit elections.ca to find your office.

At the advance polling station assigned to your home address

When:
On the Friday, Saturday, Sunday or Monday before election day

At the election day polling station assigned to your home address

When:
On election day
This is the only way you can vote on election day.

By mail from anywhere

When:
Registration deadline: until the Tuesday before election day, 6 p.m.

How:

- Register online or by mail
- Receive your special ballot kit in the mail
- Mail your ballot back to Elections Canada

Vote when you are NOT home

Important

Once you've applied to vote at an Elections Canada office or by mail, it's the **ONLY** way you can vote in this election.

Bring ID:
To vote, you need to prove your identity and address.

At any Elections Canada office

When:
Until the Tuesday before election day, 6 p.m.

How:

- Visit elections.ca to find a location close to where you work
- Register and vote in person directly at the office

Group visits are possible. Ask your work site administrator for more details.
